Pastor Matt's Summer Newsletter 2022

This summer the Church Council of Advent Lutheran Church will be sending a letter out to folks who, according to congregational records, have not maintained the requirements of membership at this church. Advent's constitution states:

"...members, during the current or preceding calendar year, shall have communed in this congregation and shall have made a (financial) contribution of record to this congregation. Members of this congregation who have satisfied these basic standards shall have the privilege of voice and vote at every regular and special meeting of this congregation as well as the other rights and privileges ascribed to voting members by the provisions of this constitution and its bylaws."

Our congregation has not reviewed the membership roles in many years. In that time the lives of our many members may have changed. Some of these changes may have affected their participation at Advent such as moving away, being homebound, financial difficulty, finding a new place of worship or the demands of life have simply distracted them from church. I would be remiss to not acknowledge that some people may have stopped participating at Advent because of a disagreement with Advent or even with the Evangelical Lutheran Church of America of which Advent is a part.

The letter being sent out by Church Council is intended to reach out to folks with loving care and understanding. It is hoped that the letter inspires renewed relationship with God at Advent or, depending on circumstances, another church. If you happen to receive the letter, please respond with your feedback. Let us know how you are and how Advent can be there for you.

Maybe you haven't been to church for a while, maybe not since the start of the pandemic, but it hasn't been two years yet. I encourage you to come back to worship in person or online. Come be spiritually nourished in the loving fellowship of Advent as you had once before. Maybe you are participating at Advent, but there is someone you have not seen at church for a while. Maybe they are a good friend or even an adult son or daughter or grandchild. Get in touch with them. Invite them back to church. God bless you and your loved ones this summer.

Bible Lesson for Kids Make a Joyful Noise

Praise Him, All You Little Children



Summer is here! We have so much to celebrate! God's creation is all around us and we can experience the beauty and majesty of his work every day!

"O come, let us sing unto the LORD:

let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation." Psalm 95:1



God is the rock of our salvation and Jesus has come alive for us! How do you like to celebrate? This summer, let's sing! Sing your own new song, sing along with your favorite music or keep a song in your heart. Listen to sweet songs sung by the birds!

Rejoice, as God is with us. Take time to celebrate his blessings all around us.

"Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all ye lands. Serve the LORD with gladness: come before his presence with singing," Psalm 100:1-2.

Musical instruments are fun to make:

- 1 Find an empty small plastic bottle, add dry beans to it and shake it to the beat of your song!
- 2 Cover the end of a 4" cardboard tube with a 4" diameter circle of waxed paper, and secure (taught) with a rubber band. Poke one hole in the side of the kazoo and blow into the open end to get your sound!
- 3 Make a "microphone" using a 4" long cardboard tube. Add a Styrofoam ball or a ball made of foil to one end and sing away!

FINANCE UPDATE

Advent's Finance Committee and Church Council thanks you for your financial support throughout the year. For the current calendar year, expenses have exceeded revenue by \$29,640. For the corresponding period last year, expenses exceeded revenue by \$14,493. The difference between last year and this year is a combination of reduced offerings and higher expenses. Advent's expenses have risen, like our own family expenses. This includes categories such as supplies & maintenance, HVAC repairs, and salaries/compensation package. For those who are able, additional offerings that you can make to close this deficit would be most appreciated.

On a positive note, your benevolence donations supporting various causes, such as Ukraine support, Lutheran World Relief, Warminster Food Bank, ELCA/Synod, and other worthy causes have totaled \$7,876 through May. This is more than double what was donated at this point last year. Thank you for your generosity in making a difference throughout the world and in our local community!

Please remember Advent during the summer months, which typically are lean ones financially. If you plan to be away, please consider mailing your offerings to the church office. Thank you.

CLOSING ON SALE OF PARCEL OF CHURCH LAND

The closing on the sale of the parcel of church land (approximately 1.25 acres) behind the church building bordering Anselm Drive was finally completed on June 8, 2022. The net proceeds of \$371,000 have been applied as follows: \$246,000 toward our existing mortgage principal, and \$125,000 will be kept by Advent towards a new church roof. We were then able to recast (reconstruct) our mortgage payments, resulting in reduced payments of \$1,500/monthly, or \$18,000 annually. We are also entering into an agreement with our lender, Mission Investment Fund, to extend our current Adjustable-Rate Mortgage (ARM) interest rate of 3.875% for an additional 5 years. This is a great deal for us, considering that the Fed has recently raised the interest rate by 1.25%. Reconstructing the mortgage at the same interest rate will save us \$90,000 over the next 5 years. Thank you for supporting the Mortgage Fund.
